Do I have to pay for the program and/or upgrades?

Depends on which program you are looking at. While the AFT, HAP, and OESP programs are FREE, the Heating and Cooling program offers an incentive towards the costs of the upgraded equipment.

Ontario Electricity Support Program



Designed to support income-eligible households with an on-bill credit

Credits can range from \$35-\$75 per electric bill for a non “Energy Intensive” home, or \$52-\$113 for an “Energy Intensive” home

Home Assistance Program

A FREE program that helps eligible applicants that are specific social benefit recipients or income-eligible make their homes more energy efficient

A home assistance technician will assess the energy efficiency of the home, including (but not limited to) lightbulbs, major appliances, draft proofing. *

*Dependant on Eligibility. Certain measures are for electric heated homes only.



Heating and Cooling Incentive



Did you know up to 60% of your annual electricity costs goes towards heating and cooling your home?

Save up to \$850 with furnace and air conditioning rebates and live more comfortably.

Electric heating? Get up to \$4,000 in heat pump rebates from Save on Energy.

AffordAbility Fund

This is a FREE program that helps Ontarians who do not qualify for low-income programs to lower their electricity use and costs at home over the long term, easing the burden of electricity bills.

There are three levels of support available depending on eligibility criteria. Measures could include (dependant on level of eligibility) LED lightbulbs, appliances, insulation, and more!
