


Electricity Prices - Effective November 1, 2021

On October 22, 2021, The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) announced that electricity prices for households and small businesses will not change as of November 1, 2021 under the Regulated Price Plan (RPP).

The winter Time-of-Use (TOU) hours and the change in the Tier threshold for residential customers on Tiered pricing will take effect November 1 as usual.

Effective November 1, 2021 the Ontario government's Ontario Electricity Rebate (OER) will be changed to 17.0%.


Power is Personal.

Choose the price plan that is right for you.

Residential & Small Business customers can choose their price plan and switch between Time-of-Use (TOU) and Tiered prices. Visit **oeb.ca/choice** for more information.

With TOU, the price you pay depends on when you use electricity. You can help manage your costs by shifting your electricity usage to lower price periods when possible.

With Tiered pricing, you can use a certain amount of electricity at a lower price. Once you exceed that threshold, a higher price applies.



Use electricity usage information from your bill and the OEB calculator to see what your total would look like under TOU and Tiered prices.

Know the Risks

The consequences of emergencies can be similar, but knowing the risks in your region can help you better prepare.



Make a Plan

Every household needs an emergency plan. It will help you and your family know what to do in an emergency and it only takes 20 minutes. Make the plan part of your emergency kit.



Get a Kit

In an emergency you will need some basic supplies. You may need to get by without power or tap water. Be prepared to be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours. Make sure your kit is easy to carry and everyone in the household knows where it is.
