Time-of-Use (TOU) Summer Hours

 On-peak	11 a.m. - 5 p.m. (Highest price)
 Mid-peak	7 a.m. - 11 a.m. & 5 p.m. - 7 p.m.
 Off-peak	7 p.m. - 7 a.m. + weekends & holidays (Lowest price)

Use electricity during evenings and weekends to save.

Tiered (Summer Thresholds)

Tier 1	Up to 600 kWh/month (Lower price)
Tier 2	Above 600 kWh/month (Higher price)

Residential threshold shown

Ultra-Low Overnight (ULO)

11 p.m. - 7 a.m. Same hours
(Lowest price) year-round

Distributed Rate Protection (DRP)



The **Distributed Rate Protection (DRP) program** helps keep distribution charges stable for eligible residential customers by setting a maximum monthly amount.



Maximum Base Distribution Charge **\$42.88 /month**

This cap applies to base distribution charges only and does not reflect total delivery charges.
